Florida Supreme Court Justice Raoul G. Cantero to speak at professionalism event May 1

WHO: Florida Supreme Court Justice Raoul G. Cantero

WHAT: Will speak to local attorneys, judges and students about professionalism

WHY: Since 2002, Justice Cantero has chaired the Florida Supreme Court's Commission on Professionalism and has spoken to both lawyers and law students on the topic. His address will kick off an afternoon of discussion between attorneys and judges about professionalism in specific areas of the law. The media is invited to join Justice Cantero, The Florida Bar President Francisco R. Angones and Volusia County Court Judge Belle B. Schumann for a student discussion about professionalism and careers in the law at 2:25 p.m. Students from the Academy of Public Service at New Smyrna Beach High School, the Academy of Law and Government at Atlantic High School, Keiser University and other schools are expected to attend. Break-out sessions for attorneys and judges will not be open to the media.

The Bench Bar Symposium is presented by the Seventh Judicial Circuit Court's Professionalism Committee and the Volusia County Bar Association and is part of the bar association's Law Week festivities.
