Most courthouses reopen tomorrow, with two continued closures

Most courthouses in the 7th Judicial Circuit will reopen tomorrow, Thursday, Sept. 14, with two continued closures, by order of Chief Judge Raul A. Zambrano. The 7th Circuit includes Flagler, Putnam, St. Johns and Volusia counties.

The Putnam County Courthouse in Palatka will remain closed for the remainder of the week. It is anticipated that this courthouse will reopen Monday, Sept. 18.

The Volusia County Courthouse Annex at City Island in Daytona Beach will remain closed tomorrow, Thursday, Sept. 14. It is anticipated that the City Island annex will reopen Friday, Sept. 15.

All other courthouse locations are scheduled to reopen tomorrow, Thursday, Sept. 14. This includes: the Kim C. Hammond Justice Center in Bunnell, the Richard O. Watson Judicial Center in St. Augustine, the Volusia County Courthouse in DeLand, the S. James Foxman Justice Center in Daytona Beach and the Volusia County Courthouse Annex in New Smyrna Beach.

During this emergency, all court deadlines will be extended and all scheduled court hearings will be rescheduled when court resumes.
