You’ll learn the answers to these questions and more during *An Afternoon at the Courthouse*, presented by the Seventh Judicial Circuit and the Volusia County Bar Association. The program will be offered from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m. Friday, April 27, in the jury assembly room at the Volusia County Courthouse, 101 N. Alabama Ave., DeLand. Participants can also attend Friday, May 4, from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m. in the jury assembly room at the Volusia County Justice Center, 251 N. Ridgewood Ave., Daytona Beach. Doors open at 1 p.m., and the program will begin promptly at 1:30 p.m.

The event is free and open to the public. Attorneys interested in attending can earn three general CLE credits.

Circuit and county judges will be providing an overview of the types of cases they handle, including criminal, civil, family and traffic. The final hour will feature a presentation by the Volusia County Bar Association that gives advice to attorneys about proper courtroom etiquette and procedure.

“This open house is a great opportunity for people to learn about the courts system,” said Volusia County Court Judge Belle B. Schumann, chair of the circuit’s professionalism committee.
