Media Plan

State of Florida v. Troy Victorino (2004-01378 CFAWS), Michael Salas (2004-01379 CFAWS), Jerone Hunter (2004-01380 CFAWS)

Pursuant to Administrative Order P-2006-046 Procedures for Special Interest/High-Profile Proceedings, the following media plan will be in place for State of Florida v. Victorino, Salas and Hunter.

General Trial Information

- Jury selection is scheduled to begin at 9 a.m. Wednesday, July 5, in Room 216 of the St. Johns County Courthouse, 4010 Lewis Speedway, St. Augustine.
- The Court anticipates keeping a schedule of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily. This schedule is subject to change.
- In the event a penalty phase becomes necessary, the Court will begin those proceedings soon after completion of the guilt phase.
- The Court requests that you dress appropriately for the courtroom.
- WiFi should be operational in the courtroom after July 3.
- There is a snack bar that serves sandwiches, etc., located in Building B for your convenience.

Media Accommodations

- The Court will allow one pool video photographer and one pool still photographer in the courtroom. An A/V feed from the courtroom can be obtained from the mult box located in the media room adjacent to the courtroom unless otherwise specified. An area at the southwest corner of the courthouse property, along side the retention pond and across the street from Central Receiving, has been designated for satellite truck parking. Parking in this area will be first-come, first-served, and only one satellite vehicle per organization will be allowed. Additional parking for vans and passenger vehicles will be available in any public parking space on the campus, one space per vehicle (this requirement will be enforced). There will be no reserved parking for print media.

- The Daytona Beach News-Journal will be the pool still photographer in the courtroom. Contact Jim Michalowski at (386) 681-2407 or jim.michalowski@news-jrnl.com or Sam Cranston at (386) 681-2248 or sam.cranston@news-jrnl.com to make photo arrangements.
- Television stations will need to determine a pool schedule on their own. Currently, the Court has no knowledge of any national networks that plan to cover the trial in its entirety.
- The press room in the rear of the courtroom will be open and available for your use while court is in session. The Court is not responsible for property left in the room. Please keep the door closed at all times. Due to the proximity to the courtroom, you must limit your activity in and out of the room.
- The Court will allow one pool video photographer and one pool still photographer to film outside of the courtroom. Photographers should not block the courtroom doors and must conduct interviews at the end of the hallway. Interviews can also be conducted in the courtyard in front of the courthouse. There will be no pool restrictions in front of the courthouse.

- Exhibits entered into evidence will be available for viewing at the end of each day during the trial. Exhibits can only be viewed and shall not be photographed.

- The St. Johns County Clerk of Court will be handling jury management. Please call Bonnie Layfield at (904) 819-3629 if you have juror-related inquiries.
- The Court reminds you to not speak with jurors or potential jurors at any point during jury selection and the trial. Please be conscious of your discussions with each other in public areas of the courthouse.
- The Court will not allow ANY photography of ANY juror or potential juror. This applies to faces, body parts, badges, etc. Failure to comply will result in your removal from the courtroom for the remainder of the trial.
- Copies of blank juror questionnaires will not be available before the jury is seated.
