Media Plan

State of Florida v. Troy Victorino (2004-01378 CFAWS), Michael Salas (2004-01379 CFAWS), Jerone Hunter (2004-01380 CFAWS)

Pursuant to Administrative Order P-2006-046 Procedures for Special Interest/High-Profile Proceedings, the following media plan will be in place for State of Florida v. Victorino, Salas and Hunter.

General Trial Information

- Jury selection is scheduled to begin at 9 a.m. Monday, April 10, in Courtroom 1 of the Volusia County Courthouse in DeLand.
- The Court anticipates keeping a schedule of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily. This schedule is subject to change. The Court will be closed on Friday, April 14, for the Good Friday holiday.
- In the event a penalty phase becomes necessary, the Court will begin those proceedings soon after completion of the guilt phase.
- The Court requests that you dress appropriately for the courtroom.

Media Accommodations

- The Court will allow one pool video photographer and one pool still photographer in the courtroom. An A/V feed from the courtroom can be obtained from the mult box located in the south parking lot. There will be reserved parking for FIVE TV trucks and ONE radio truck in the south lot. There will be no reserved parking for print media.
- The viewing room in the back of the courtroom will NOT be used as a “media room” for photographing/filming purposes. If necessary, reporters may be asked to sit in the viewing room if seating in the courtroom becomes an issue.
- The Daytona Beach News-Journal will be the pool still photographer in the courtroom.
- Television stations will need to determine a pool schedule on their own.
- The press room at the courthouse will be open and available for your use while court is in session. The Court is not responsible for property left in the room. Please keep the door closed at all times. The press room is located on the first floor in room C126.

- The Court will allow one pool video photographer and one pool still photographer to film outside of the courtroom. Photographers should not block the courtroom doors and must conduct interviews at the end of the hallway. Interviews can also be conducted in front of the courthouse outside of the secured area. There will be no pool restrictions in front of the courthouse.

- Exhibits entered into evidence will be available for viewing at the end of each day during the trial. Exhibits can only be viewed and shall not be photographed.

Juror Information

- The Clerk of Court handles jury management. Please call (386) 822-5710 if you have juror-related inquiries.
- The Court reminds you to not speak with jurors or potential jurors at any point during jury selection and the trial. Please be conscious of your discussions with each other in public areas of the courthouse.
- The Court will not allow ANY photography of ANY juror or potential juror. This applies to faces, body parts, badges, etc. Failure to comply will result in your removal from the courtroom for the remainder of the trial.
- Copies of blank juror questionnaires will not be available before the jury is seated.
